The school along with Stagecoach Bus operate a daily bus service directly to the school, that can only be used by our students.

The bus will be numbered C1 and will stop at all stops on the route, not just those mentioned. A map of the route can be found at the end of this letter.

Payment will be collected throughout the year and is priced at £125 per half term with a 10% discount for each additional child booked onto the bus to be paid through ParentPay. (sibling discount will be applied once the academic year starts)


Payment plans are available, with the amount paid in instalments to suit your individual circumstances, meaning monthly, weekly, or termly payments will be fine.

This figure includes each journey to and from school as well as unlimited bus travel at any time of day including evening, weekend and school holidays (excluding Summer) on Stagecoach buses in the Chester area. Each student will be issued with a Smartcard that will be for their use only, this will need to be shown to gain access to the bus. If your child loses their pass during the year, they will not be allowed to get on the bus until a new pass has been issued to them by the school office. A small fee may be payable should your child lose their pass



The Smartcard pass will be issued from school once the initial payment has been made the pass can be collected from the school office from Wednesday 4th September onwards. For Year 7 students, they will receive their pass via their form teacher. Please note that the bus service starts on Thursday 5th September, so if appliable, alternative transport arrangements will need to be made for Wednesday 4th September.

If at any point in the year you no longer need the pass, then please return it to the school office and we will arrange for your account to be closed at that point and we will you inform you of any outstanding costs that need to be made.
