

## **Consultation on proposed Schools Admission Arrangements 2026/2027**

The Catholic High School, Chester is carrying out a consultation on the proposed admission arrangements for admission in September 2026 for the 2026/2027 Academic year.

Admission arrangements are the overall procedure, practices and oversubscription criteria used in deciding the allocation of school places.

The consultation is being carried out by the Governing Body, as the Admissions Authority of the school on behalf of the Trust – The Chester Catholic Academies Partnership.

The only change in this consultation is a permanent reduction of the Published Admissions Numbers (PAN) from 165 to 150 from 2026/2027 onwards

The Governing Body is fulfilling its statutory duty to consult at least every seven years.
